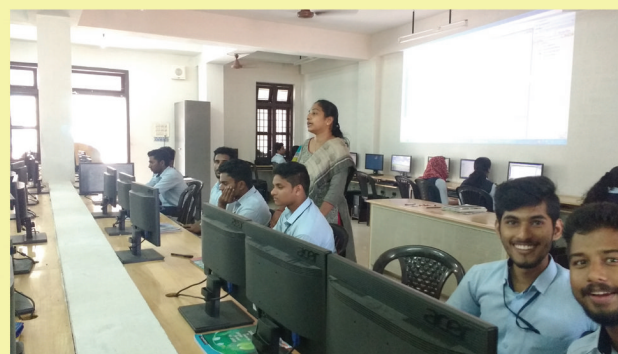
## DEPARTMENT OF COMPUTER APPLICATION
