The following programs were conducted during the 7-day camp.

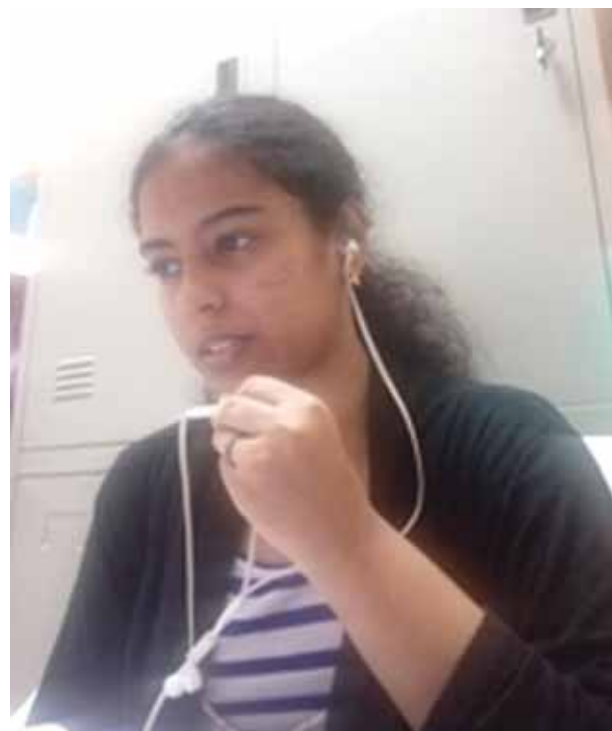

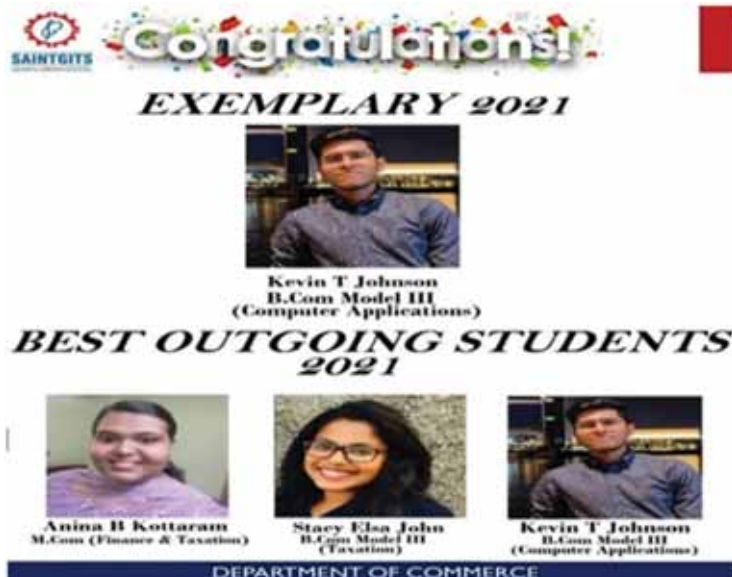

Third year students, (2017-20) batch, in their final semester secured 98% and second year students (2018-21) secured 97% for their fourth semester. First year students (2019-22) got 94% for their second semester and 80% for their first semester respectively.

Various Student development programmes initiated by the department are listed below :

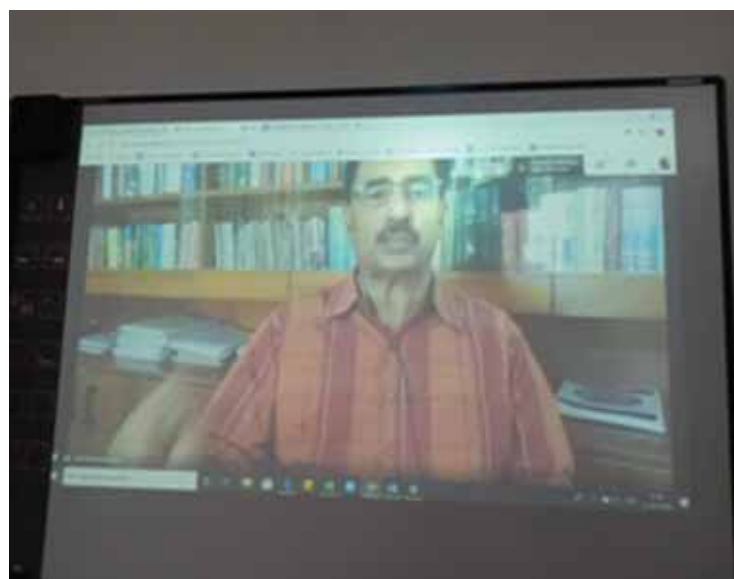
- **Internship Programme online** – Students of final year were interns at Learnovate Company and IMUN for which appreciation certificates were received.
