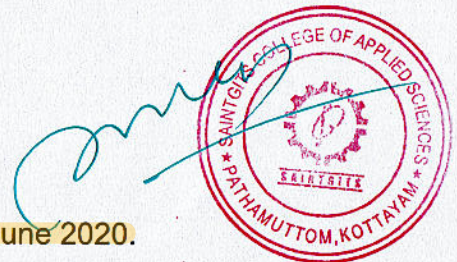
### **FDP/WORKSHOP**

### **HE FOR SHE CLUB**

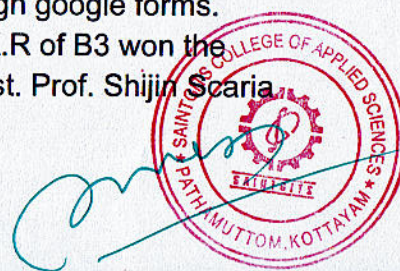

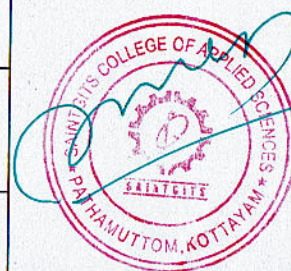
### **DEPARTMENT OF BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION**

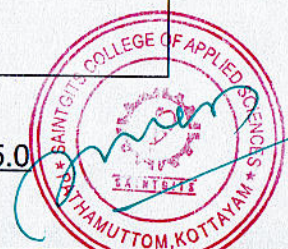

#### WEBINARS AND EVENTS ORGANIZED BY THE DEPARTMENT

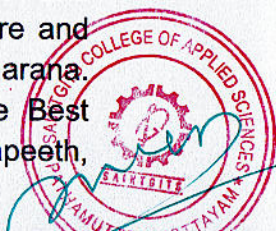
