Herbal Garden Inaugration

June 5<sup>th</sup> was celebrated in Saintgits College of Applied Sciences by NSS volunteers by planting an herbal garden which was inaugurated by our Principal Prof. M.C Joseph. This was a huge step taken on Environment day to make our surroundings a better place.

Distribution of study materials to the students of Govt. LP School, Pathamuttom:

NSS volunteers of Saintgits College of Applied Sciences went for a visit to the Govt. School in Pathamuttom and gifted them with a kit of study items .The Govt. School consisted of 27 students. They interacted happily and sang songs. They were happy to receive the gifts.

#### Special camp:

The NSS volunteers of Saintgits College of Applied Sciences took part in a special camp held in the college premises from 21st-27th December. A group of 35 students participated in the camp under the guidance of David Joseph (Program officer, NSS). Theme selected for this year was 'SUKRTHAM' 2018, which emphasized on the topic of waste management and spread awareness to different people in different places.

#### Flood Relief Activities:

National Service Scheme of Saintgits College of Applied Sciences visited flood relief camp in Panachikadu village and handed over grocery items in the presence of Mr.Arun (village officer of Paninchikkadu) and handed over the collected clothes to Mrs.Sajimol (Kudumbasree chairperson, Manarcadu) for the flood relief camp in Manarcadu village on 24th of July 2018. Each kit carried the following items Rice 5kg, Sugar-1kg, Pulses-500kg, Oil-1/2kg, Tea powder-250gms, Chilly/turmeric/sambar powder I packet each, biscuits -2packets, bath soap-2 and washing soap-1. On 19th August 2018, NSS members of Saintgits conducted flood relief programmes at various flood affected areas of Panachikkadu and PuthuppallyPanchayat and distributed kits consisting of 4 items- Towel, Bedsheet, Soap, Nighty (Women)and lungi (Men). In addition to the dress kits 185 food packets were provided for the campers at ChoorachiraGovt LP School. A large number of staff and students helped in arranging this much food packets in time. On 20th August 2018 flood relief programmes were conducted at various camps of Kottayam. Kits were distributed at Pathiyapally, Sankarapuram, Chingavanam, Kanjiram, Sankranthi and Irayilkadav. Total kits distributed this day are 182-gents kit and 210-ladies kit.
