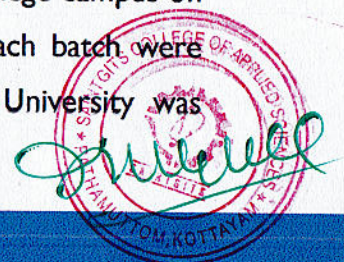
ORIENTATION DAY

CHRISTMAS CELEBRATION

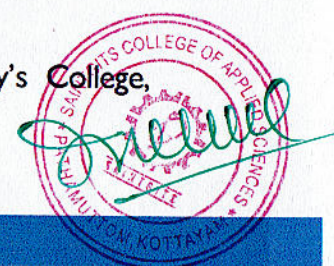

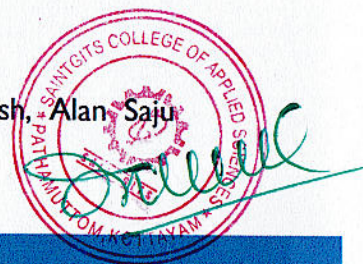
HOUR OF CODE

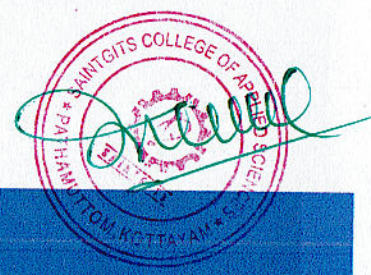

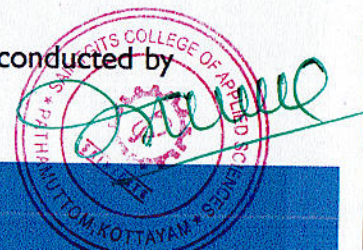

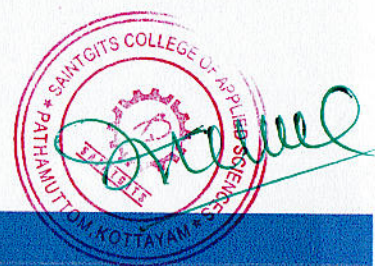
