INDUCTION PROGRAM

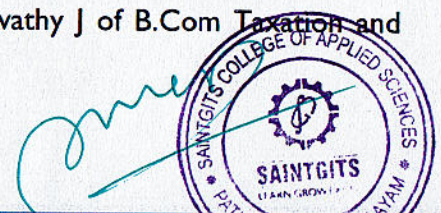

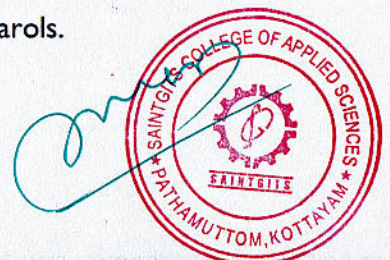

NAAC PREPARATION

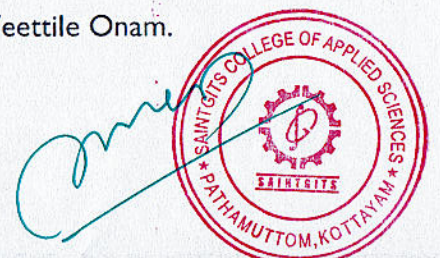

The Talents Day of the final year students was conducted on 4th March 2022.

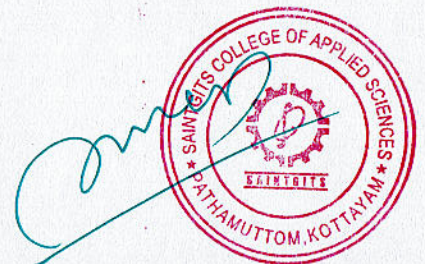
The Arts Day logo launching was done by our Principal Dr. K. K. John.

SPORTS EVENTS

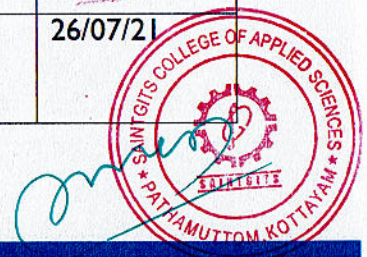
'SCAS Premier League' was conducted on 28th February and 2nd March. The tournament started with a shootout game for students and staff of the college. 15 teams participated in the tournament.

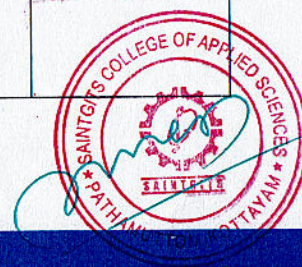

2. Bridge Course

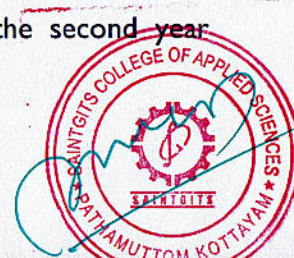

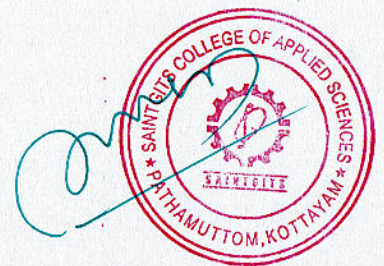


I.INTERNATIONAL WEBINARS

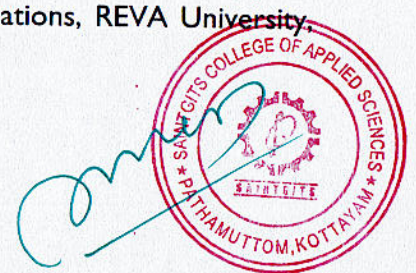

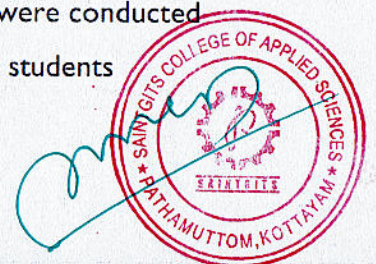
10. Orientation Program for PG students

- A talk by Mr Roshan and Ms Navya about the cybercrimes for C6 students



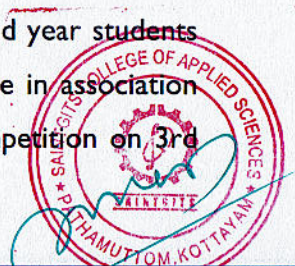
- On 5th January a session about cybercrimes and its impact was given to C2 students by Mr Motti.

March,2022 and Champions Tournament (Mobile Gaming) on 5th March,2022 for first year and third year students.

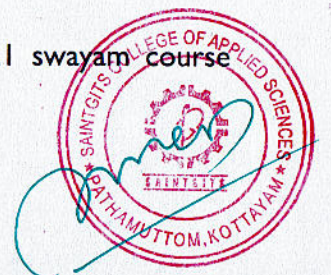
- Department signed an MOU with Infosys private limited to access the learning platform “head start” for final year students.

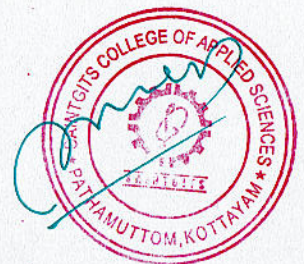

Study Tour

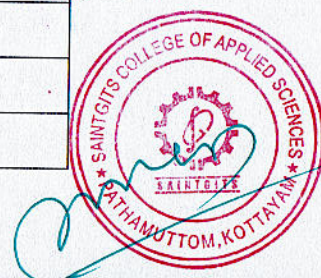

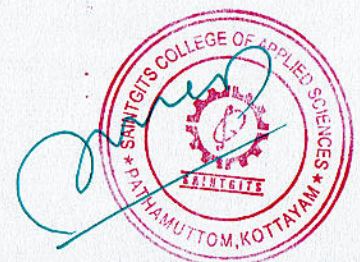
DEPARTMENT OF CORPORATE ECONOMICS

- **Value Added courses** were also offered which include BEC, Introduction to Econometrics and Industrial Economics.

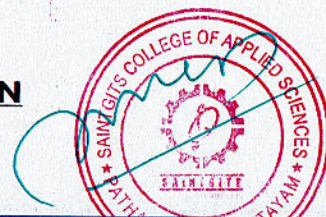

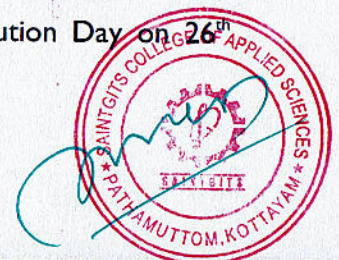
ACTIVITIES- 'ARTHA' ECONOMIC ASSOCIATION

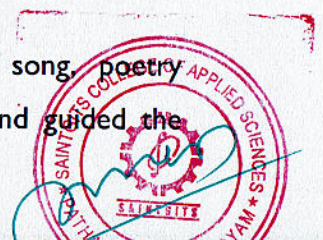
DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHOLOGY
