During the session she highlighted the pros and cons of opting for teaching as a career in commerce. She highlighted the need to focus on the add-ons needed to move ahead in the field such as


- -need to qualify Net



Q.2 There is a common opinion that women are better for leadership roles than men. What is your opinion?


It may be true. I think it depends on situations, type of the organisation and many other factors. Anyway it is true that a working homemaker is better in keeping work life balance than a man.


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REPORT

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

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
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REPORT

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
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DOORSTEPS TO YOUR FUTURE CAREER REPORT
