Placements-

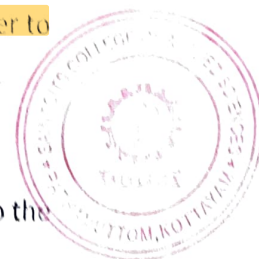
The committee recommended that final year students who wish to appear for placement interviews should be given sufficient support from the placement cell.
