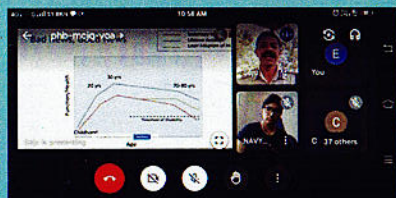


# CLUBS & OTHER ACTIVITIES

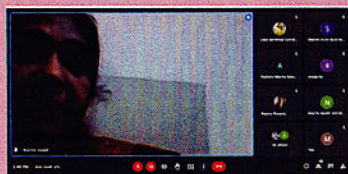


## WOMEN CELL

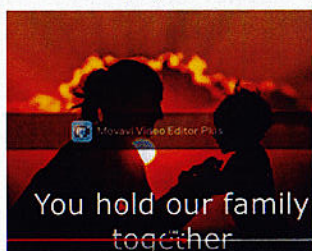


### HEFORSHE POSTER MAKING COMPETITION

## LIFE SKILLS CLUB

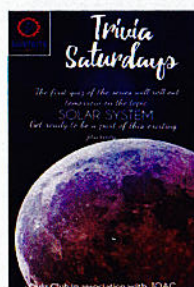

### Computer Society of India

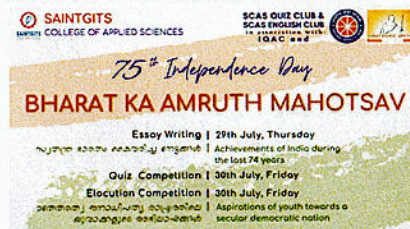
CSI SCAS STUDENT BRANCH

### UNNATH BHARAT ABHIYAN



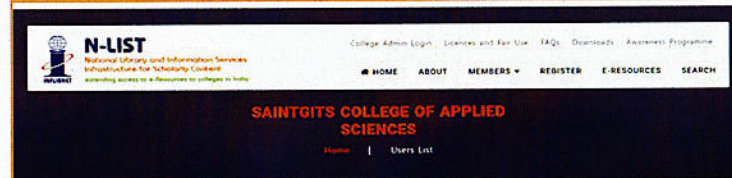

3. The Innovation vertical of YUVA organized a bookmark making competition on 21st March 2022 with regards to World Happiness Day.

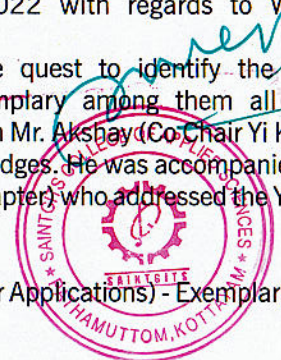

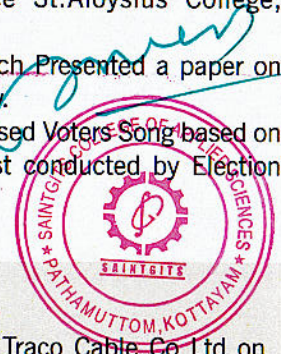

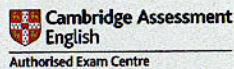


## DEPARTMENT OF LANGUAGES

The department offers an add-on course (Business English Certificate) by Cambridge University to the first year students of Commerce, Business Administration, Psychology and Corporate Economics Departments.



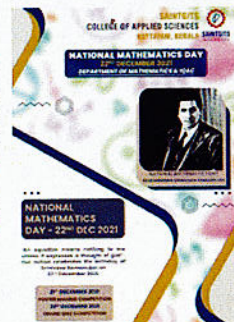
### Webinar

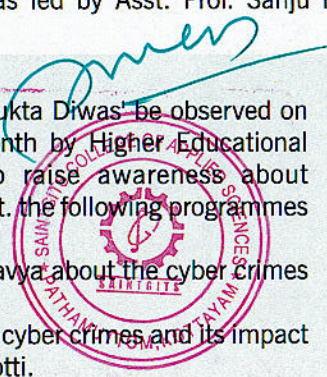
**Orientation Program for PG students**

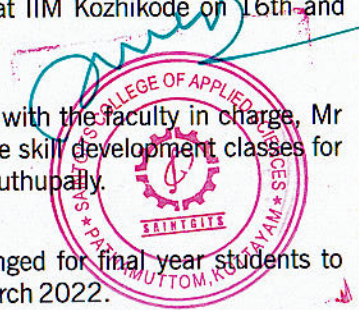
Ten students from final year BBA presented research papers at the 2nd International Conclave held at IIM Kozhikode on 16th and 18th December 2021.

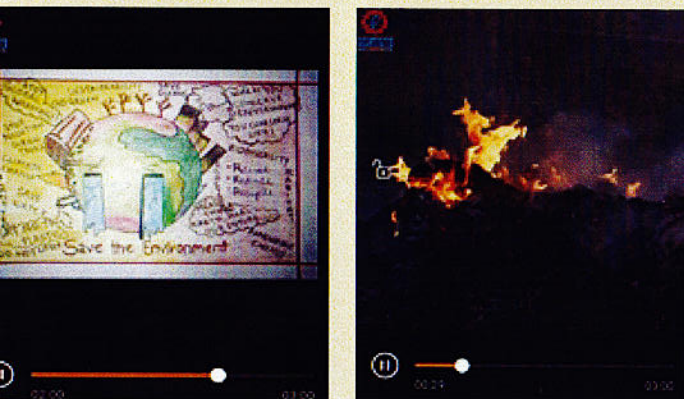
