SAINTGITS COLLEGE OF APPLIED SCIENCES MINUTES OF GENERAL STAFF COUNCIL MEETING HELD ON 28th JUNE 2021

Venue: Seminar Hall Time: 10.00am

The meeting started with a silent prayer.

- Principal Dr. K K John congratulated Exam Cell Coordinator Asst. Prof. Arun Padmanabhan and his team for the efficient conduct of online examination for 2nd and 4th semester students. Principal explained the question paper pattern of 6th semester university examination.
- Asst. Prof. Sherin Mary Andrews of BCA, is nominated as the convenor of Covid Protocol Committee during the academic year 2021-2022.
- Asst. Prof. Anish B Bhaskaran, HOD, Commerce is nominated as the general coordinator of Social Distancing Committee.
- Principal Dr. K K John congratulated Asst. Prof. Preetha Thomas and Asst. Prof.Sreeja KS,for handling Social Service Committee effectively. The social Service Committee contributed an amount to Ms.Devu of M.Com student and Mr. Aravind of former BA Corporate Economics student.
- Principal Dr. K K John informed that all the teachers should submit a report on lock down
 - Activities from 16th April to 18th June 2021.
- Er. Punnose George, Executive chairman informed about the unique policy of Saintgits and suggested that all the staff members are to appreciate the uniqueness of the institutional policy. He also suggested to maintain communicative skills between the staff every day. He also said that the staff should be responsible to each other.
- Prof. M.C Joseph, associate director of SCAS explained about different topics of value education, which should be implemented in the coming semesters. Value Education will be conducted as one period per month for each class during the regular class hours.
- Asst. Prof. Preetha Thomas is nominated as the general club coordinator. She informed that each club coordinator should conduct at least 2 programmes in a semester and all the club coordinators should submit a proposal and a budget regarding the same. She informed that a team constituting asst. profs Vidya R Nair, Anju Ann Abraham, Rani Tom, Manu Mohan and Arun Padmanabhan prepared a question bank consisting of around 3000 questions covering areas of General Studies, Business, History, Politics, Computer Science, English, Maths and Sports for the benefit of the students.
- Asst. Prof. Sreeja KS, open course coordinator informed that open course classes will be conducted from Monday to Thursday. A Screening test will be conducted on the subjects Applicable Mathematics and Brand Management for shortlisting the students.
- Principal Dr. K K John informed that, after the 6th semester university examination 5th semester supplementary exams will continue and after that 2 days CV camp will be conducted. A viva should be conducted through online mode and faculties should take a photograph for the same with date.

- Asst. Prof. Ambily Merlin Kuruvilla, HOD BCA informed that, for the need of collaborating with foreign university BCA department made a search about the needed details.
- Principal Dr. K K John, suggested to conduct a 4 day FDP by SCAS staff.
- Principal Dr. K K John informed that our alumni registration should be encouraged and SDP's should be promoted.
- Asst. Professor Reshmi Susan Jacob, Academic coordinator BA, informed that BA department will conduct an inter institutional union budget analysis competition. A proposal is put forwarded before the management for the approval.
- Principal Dr. K K John informed that Bridge Courses and Orientation programmes will be conducted in this academic year. Management gave permission to conduct Arts fest and similar programmes through online mode.
- Asst. Prof. Tania Thomas, HOD, BBA informed that department is conducting an online chess Tournament to provide a platform for students to improve their Logical Thinking, Analytic Reasoning and Problem-Solving Skills. First year and Second year students can participate for the same.
- As part of international day against Drug abuse, department of Commerce is organising a Cartoon drawing competition for the 1st year and 2nd year students.
- Asst.Prof. Joshyja Jose BBA informed that she has motivated the students to do
 internship and also started a WhatsApp group, in which the students of second
 years and third years joined. Around 34 students out of 55 from 2019-22 batch
 started internship during the lockdown period. She also informed that the 'He For
