Tell us your opinion about the role of women in education.

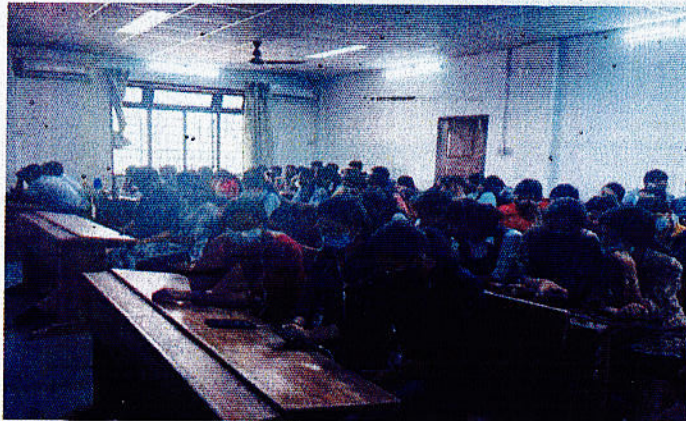
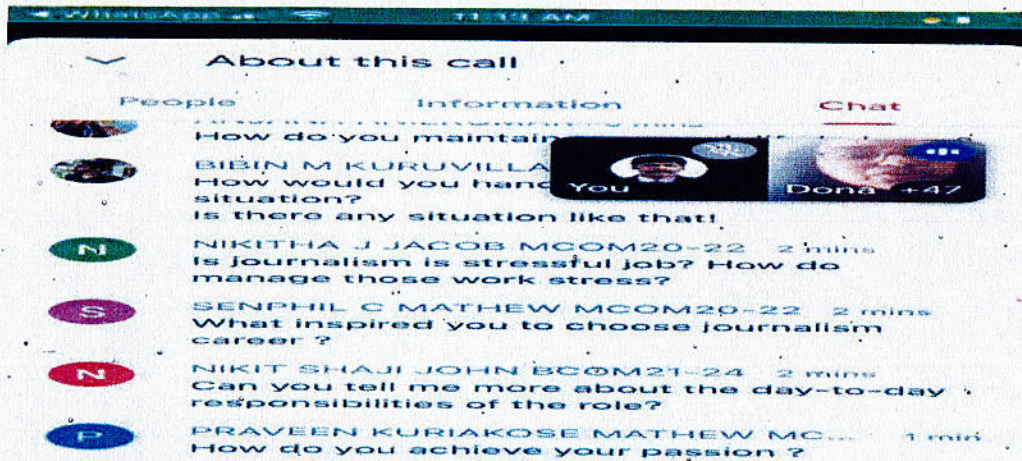
