SAINTGITS GREEN POLICY

The following Green protocol guidelines are being practiced in the college to protect the nature and the environment and our Mother Earth

1. Waste water in the campus is recycled and reused to water plants and trees in the campus.
2. Encourage students to use cloth banners when programs are organized in the campus, thereby avoiding flex.
3. Motivate students to use paper pens and paper files, when seminars, workshops and meetings are organized.
4. Segregate waste generated in to biodegradable and non-biodegradable and burn non-biodegradable using incinerator.
5. Remind staff and students to switch off lights, fans and water taps when not in use.
6. Promote use of cloth bags instead of plastic bags.
7. College Nature club is directed to organize nature tour to forests and natural habitats to study and experience nature in depth.
8. Students are instructed to bring food and drinking water in stainless steel utensils and avoid the use of plastic disposable items.
9. Collect electrical and electronic wastes and forward these to scrapdealers for recycling
10. Green protocol posters are prepared and exhibited in the college.
11. NSS unit of the college is directed to promote organic farming in the locality.
12. Youth Enrichment through Scholars (YETS) is authorized to conduct classes etiquette every year to teach students not to waste food and also table manners.
13. NSS volunteers are encouraged to participate in the clean Kerala campaign.
14. Environmental studies are included in the curriculum of M G university as per direction from U.G.C
15. Students are advised to use and promote 'LED bulbs' and other energy saving devices.
16. Avoid and minimise the use of printed materials in the college. Announcements and notices are to be made through public announcement system and electronic media the college.
17. Provide adequate numbers of dust bins in class rooms and premises for depositing waste materials thereby making campus eco-friendly.
18. Waste plastic materials and waste paper, are sold to scrap dealers instead of burning.
