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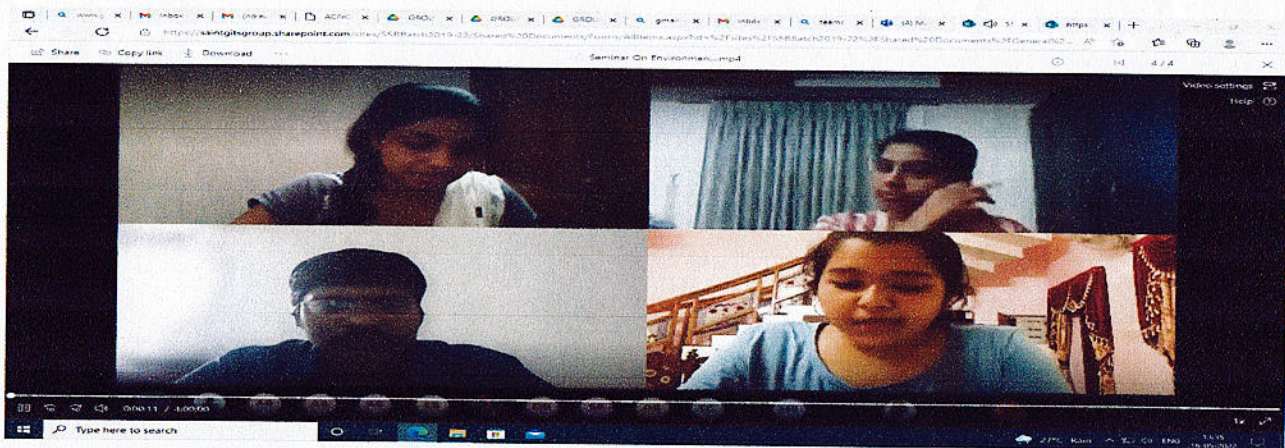
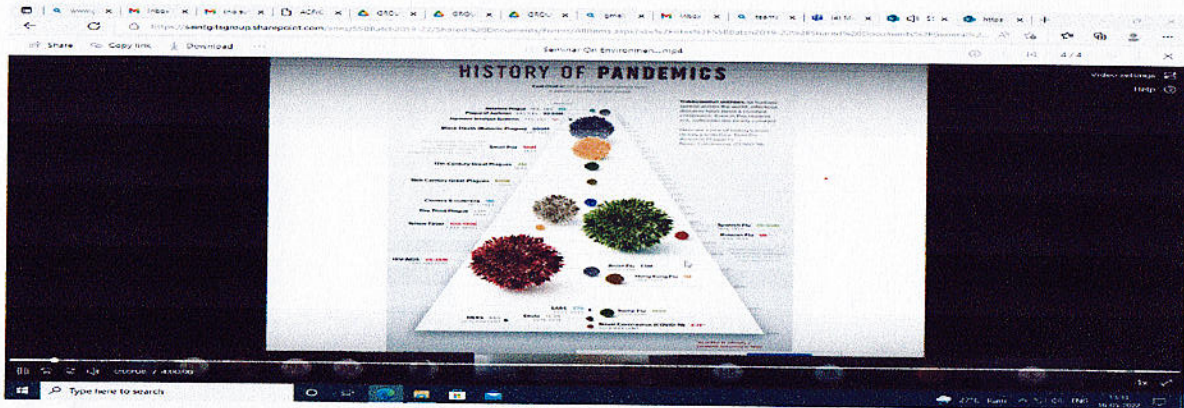

Assessment and Evaluation: The module enables faculties to create assessments and evaluations easily. It also provides tools for grading and analyzing the performance of students.

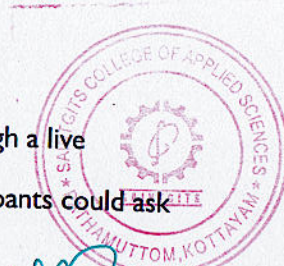

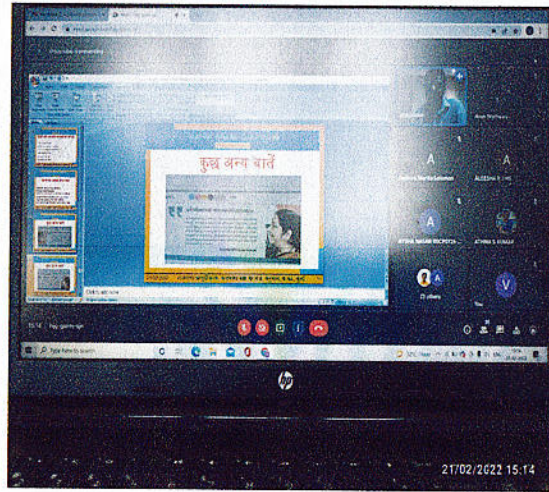

In general, students were satisfied about the content delivery and they find it useful for their further education plans. Students suggested to conduct more session through offline

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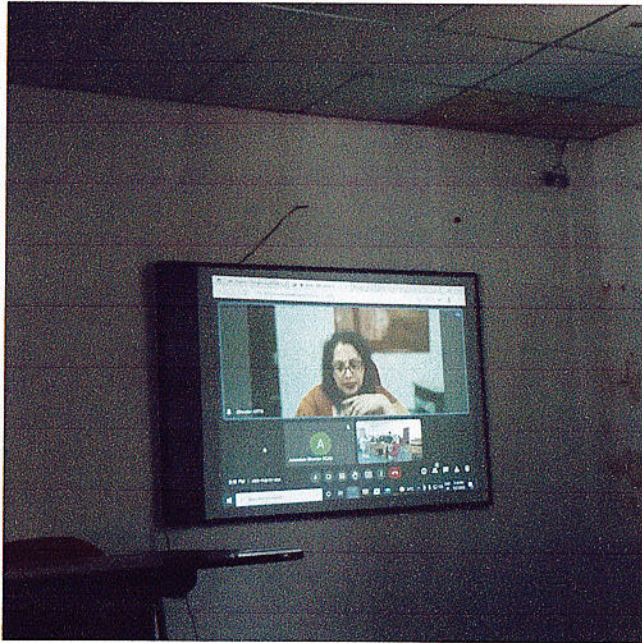
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and asked to include more discussions on gender neutral topics, table etiquette behaviour and other inspirational talks. All the suggestions from the students were taken positively.

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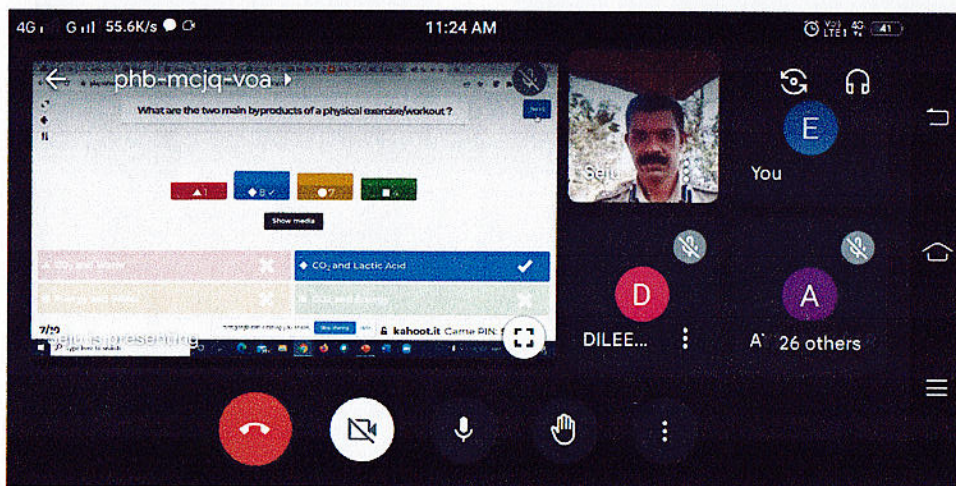
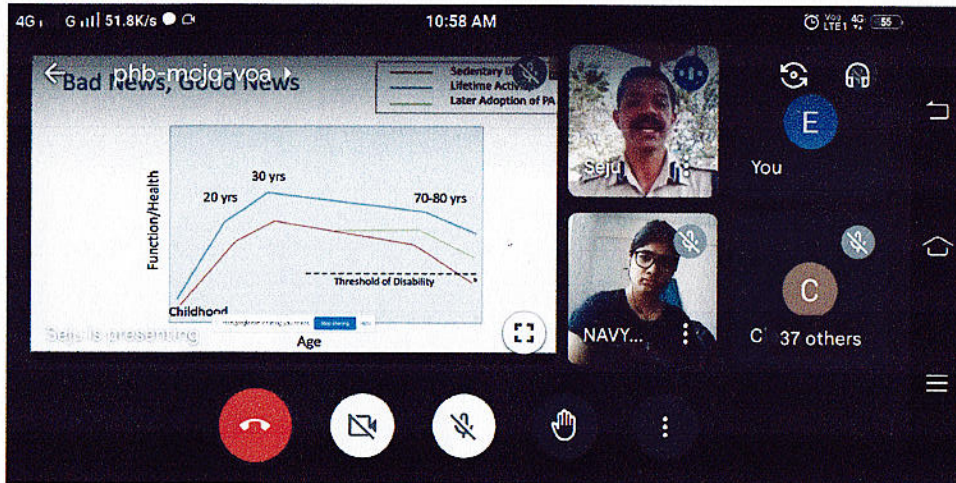
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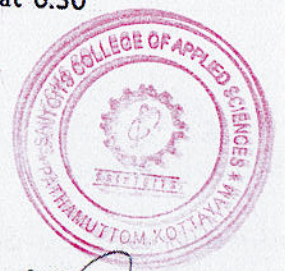
DEPARTMENT OF COMMERCE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22 INDUSTRIAL VISIT REPORT


An industrial visit has been conducted for students of fourth semester B. Com students and second M Com students to Traco Cable company Ltd, Irumpanam, Ernakulam and Wonderla Amusement Park on 18th May 2022. Total 142 students and 7 faculties participated in the industrial visit.

Journey started from the college at 6:30 am and reached Traco Cable Company Limited by 10:00 am. A brief introduction about industry was given by the staff. Firstly, they were taken to the production area where the staff explained the whole mechanism of the cables being produced by continuous spiraling of thin cables using the machine. Then they headed to the Quality Assurance room where two tests of determining the quality of cables were explained briefly. Also, the staff mentioned the benefits, usage and the main users of the cables. An example is our government buying cables for electricpost. Later they were taken to the transportation area and the various methods were shown.

Students moved out of the plant at 12:00 PM and reached Wonderla at 12:40 PM. They visited the finance department of Wonderla amusement park. They were explained about the internal check system in the department. After the visit to the finance department, they spent some time in the amusement park for entertainment. Return journey started at 6:30 PM and reached the college at 11 PM. and by 11 pm we reached the college campus.


As part of the Internal Online FDP series organized by Saintgits College of Applied Sciences, the Department of Corporate Economics handled a session on 'Banking Trends in India' on 14th June 2021 through Googlemeet. The session began by the welcome address by Principal, Dr. K. K. John. Asst. Prof. Reshmi Susan Jacob and Asst. Prof. Aadhira Merita Solomon jointly did the presentation. The session was focussed on the recent trends taking place in the Indian banking sector. The first half of the session was delivered by Asst. Prof. Reshmi Susan Jacob where she detailed the history of banking in India. The area of discussion included the history of banking in pre-independence period followed by growth of indigenous banking system. Later major incidents like evolution of State Bank of India and nationalization of banks were also explained. The second half of the session was on Basil Norms which was handled by Asst. It was followed by nationalisation of 14 banks in 1969 and 6 banks in 2000. It paved way to rescue many private sector banks which were in loss in the preceding time period. The main objective was to ensure that financial institutions have enough capital with them to meet their obligations and absorb unexpected losses. The session was concluded by the remarks by Associate Director, Prof. M.


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Mentoring
